For Example on #4: Barker has the 1st pick in the 2nd round, 10th overall. If the coordinator was hired as an NFL head coach for 2020 that 10th overall pick would change to a 9th pick of the 1st round, 9th overall. If the coordinator was last in yardage rank then it would be a 4th pick of the 2nd round, 14th overall.
